One of our funding efforts with a further purpose is our CAP Conference Programme, 2009.

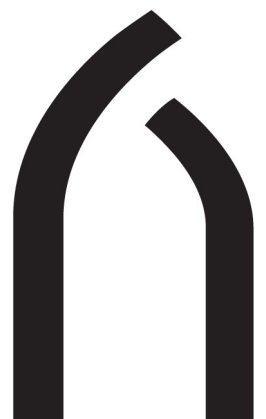
The Partnership Conference is the first in a series of Conferences to benefit organisations as well as the CAP. The list of speakers is wide ranging and each has been given the same brief:

This is also having an impact on employment and it is our fear that numbers of homeless people will rise.
